Puerto Rico is the rum capital of the world and Old San Juan is the fun capital of Puerto Rico, so it was almost inevitable that someone would put together an event that would combine the two, add some great food in a great restaurant, and offer the results to happy visitors!



Last October, Legends of Puerto Rico, one of the island's most innovative tour companies (famous for its walking tours of Old San Juan) created San Juan Nights. It teamed up with Rums of Puerto Rico and some of the Old City's best restaurants to offer groups of four to 12 people an insight into Puerto Rico's finest flavors...and the rest is history!

The flavors, of course, are of rum and rum-inspired food. Up to 16 different rums are tasted during the 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. event. There are three flights of thimble-size servings that include a blind tasting of basic, aged, and flavored rums—each presented by a professionally trained guide. These are paired with six to eight dishes of delicious criollo-inspired cuisine, a few rum cocktails (what would a night of rum be without a Piña Colada or an exotic Rum Cocotini?), and completed with a dessert of *coquito*, a smooth rum and coconut cream confection.

Although it sounds like a party, San Juan Nights is actually both educational and entertaining. Sure, you have to be at least 25 years old to participate, and you should assign a designated driver or choose the optional round-trip transportation, but the total amount imbibed is reasonable and the amount of information you learn is considerable. More important, you meet real *sanjuaneros* (San Juan residents) and take home a taste of authentic Puerto Rico nightlife.
